

Tournament Director's Notes

We had a smaller group for the last tournament of 2014. I must commend everyone for returning their entry replies so timely allowing for the schedules to be distributed right on time. We welcomed new comer, Dennis Kreil (finally after three previous tries) who filled in for Borden who was complaining of a sore hip. Also filling in at the last minute was Ray Caldwell who was one of our good men to round out our numbers to make them even and Margo Milligan who filled in for Susan Dow who we hope recovered from a nasty case of the flu.

Updated Ladder Coming

Our next session will be a straight format and again it will be round robin for each selected pool. I trust our updated ladder will be available and I plan to finally publish it on the website so that everyone can review our committee's efforts. The updating of the ladder has been in the works for several months (actually years). The committee won't make all happy but will issue guidance to your tournament director which is long overdue.

Prior to our February tournament we can address challenges to our ladder if anyone feels it is appropriate. I feel the best way to improve my own standing is hard work and successful finals play. The purpose of the ladder is to make play levels more fair. Our policy that players aren't matched together within a two year period prevents individuals from being paired up with their buddy too often. This also will make the individual who calls and proclaims that if they are not placed in the upper pool all the time they won't come at all showing their lack of commitment to our club. The ladder removes the sole decisions away from the tournament director, however, if a player needs to be placed higher on the ladder, I will argue to the committee as to why a change is recommended. We certainly realize that players like Harriet's granddaughter, Nikki Wakeland, showed massive improvement in just a short 6 month period and will be evaluated on her skill and not her age in future tournaments. This will help us welcome more youth and enjoy watching the development of a new player.

A Successful Comeback

Lastly, it was wonderful to see Ursula Hawkins stronger than ever during the final match. To think it was just last year she was unable to play at all and she has exhibited that her hard work at physical recovery has been successful and to see her return of stamina. She is definitely an example we can all admire.
